Established by India's banking industry in April 1968 under the Companies Act, 1956, AFC has an authorised capital of INR 1000 million with subscribed and paid up capital of INR 150 million. AFC's membership consists of twenty public sector banks (including State Bank of India), twelve private sector banks, six foreign banks, two development financial institutions (NABARD and EXIM Bank) and one cooperative bank. AFC is a Deemed Government Company under Section 139 (5) and 139 (7) of the Companies Act, 2013 and its accounts are audited by Comptroller & Auditor General of India (CAG). It is an ISO 9001-2008 certified Company.

Board of Directors

AFC is governed by a Board of Directors which comprises Senior Officers of Development Financial Institutions, public sector banks and eminent experts from the field of Agriculture, Rural Development and Finance and a whole time Managing Director. One of the Directors is the elected Chairman of the Board. A standing committee of the Board attends to policy, administration and other financial matters.
